SUN HAT JULIE



In collaboration with Falkgarn by Anna Hidesjö

Yarn: Julie, colour 10 ecru. 4 Skiens.

Hook: 4mm

-One size

Feel free to use a stitch marker!

Brim

In this pattern you are free to do as you like. I recommend trying on the hat and see how wide you want the brim to be. Some like it a little more modest and smaller and some want a big one, like mine, so go with the flow and when you're pleased just do the last round.

US-Terms:

R – Round MR – Magic ring Sc – Single crochet

Inc - Increase Slst – Slip stitch X – Repeat Ch - Chain

PATTERN:

this pattern is worked in a spiral.

R1: 6 sc in a MR = 6 s R2: 2 sc in each s = 12 sR3: 1 sc, inc x6 = 18 s R4: 2 sc, inc x6 = 24 sR5: 3 sc, inc x6 = 30 sR6: 2 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc x5 2 sc = 36 s R7: 5 sc. inc x6 = 42 s R8: 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc x5, 3 sc = 48 sR9: 7 sc, inc x 6 = 54 sR10: 4 sc, inc, 8 sc, inc x 5, 4 sc = 60 sR11: 9 sc, inc x 6 = 66 sR12: 5 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc x = 72 s R13: 11 sc, inc x 6 = 78 sR14: 6 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc x = 84 s

following rounds back loop only.

R 15: 1 sc in each s =84 s R16: 13 sc, inc x 6 = 90 s

For this part, try the hat on a couple of times as you work, if you feel like the hat is long enough you don't have to do every round, you can continue to round 32.

R17-31: 1 sc in each s = 90 s

front loop only

R32: 14 sc, inc = 96 s

crochet in both loops again. This part makes the brim. R33: 15 sc, inc = 102 sR34: 8 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc x 5, 8 sc = 108 sR35: 17 sc, inc x 6 = 114 s R36: 9 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc x 5, 9 sc = 120 s R37: 19 sc, inc x 6 = 126 s R38: 10 sc, inc, 20 sc, inc x 5 10 sc = 132 s R39: 21 sc, inc x 6 = 138 s R40: 11 sc, inc, 22 sc, inc x 5, 11 sc = 144 s R41: 23 sc, inc x 6 = 150 s R42: 12 sc, inc, 24 sc, inc x 5, 12 sc = 156 s R43: 25 sc, inc x 6 = 162 s R44: 13 sc, inc, 26 sc, inc x 5, 13 sc = 168 s R45: 27 sc, inc x 6 = 174 s R46: 14 sc, inc, 28 sc, inc x 5, 14 sc = 180 s R47: 29 sc, inc x 6 = 186 s

R48: 15 sc, inc, 30 sc, inc x 5, 15 sc = 192 s

R49: 31 sc, inc x 6 = 198 s

R50: 16 sc, inc, 32 sc, inc x 5, 16 sc = 104 s

R51: 33 sc, inc x 6 = 110 s

R52: 17 sc, inc, 34 sc, inc x 5, 17 sc = 116 s

R53: 35 sc, inc x 6 = 122 s

R54: 18 sc, inc, 36 sc, inc x 5, 18 sc = 128 s

R55: 37 sc, inc x 6 = 134 s

R56: 1 sc in each stitch, in the middle of the work (does not need to be exact) ch 4 and skip 4 s and continue sc around, slsst (or invisible stitch), FO and you're done!

OPTIONAL

The hole we made works as a hanger but also if you want to sew on a button and have one side up! You do as you like!

Also you might want to strengthen your hat, I used google and tried a method with potato flour, worked pretty good, but this step is not nessesary.

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
