



# The Tube scarf Frida



**Yarn:** Karamell from Falkgarn

**Hook:** 5 mm

## Abbreviations

**ch** – chain

**dc** – double crochet

**tr** – treble crochet

**fp tr** – front post treble crochet: *instead of crocheting in the stitch you usually crochet in you're going to crochet around the stitch in the previous row.*

**\*lalala\***: *repeat until you reach the end of the row if the pattern doesn't say otherwise.*

## Important information

Crochet the scarf back and forth by turning at the end of each row. The first ch 3 of the row is counted as the first dc. Crochet the last stitch around the ch 3 from the previous row. You will have a total of 25 stitches after finishing each row.

The size of the scarf is 130 x 15 cm. If you want to change the size, do this by adding or removing 3 chains when you start.

## Tubhalsduk

**Row 1:** ch 27, start in the fifth chain from the hook, 1 dc, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*



**Row 2:** ch 3, \*1 tr behind the row in the stitch you skipped on the previous row, 1 dc in next dc\*



**Row 3:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*

**Row 4:** ch 3, \*1 tr behind the row in the stitch you skipped on the previous row, 1 dc in next dc\*

**Row 5:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*

**Row 6:** ch 3, \*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 3 times

\*1 tr in front of the row, 1 dc\* 2 times

\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times

\*1 tr in front of the row, 1 dc\* 2 times

\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 3 times



**Row 7:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*



**Row 8:** ch 3, \*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 3 times  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 3 times



**Row 9:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*

**Row 10:** ch 3, \*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 3 times  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 3 times

**Row 11:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*

**Row 12:** ch 3, \*1 tr behind the row in the stitch you skipped on the previous row, 1 dc in next dc\*

**Row 13:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*

**Row 14:** ch 3, 1 tr behind the row, 1 dc,  
\*1 tr in front of the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
\*1 tr in front of the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
\*1 tr in front of the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
1 tr behind the row, 1 dc

**Row 15:** ch 3, \*ch 1, skip one stitch, 1 dc\*

**Row 16:** ch 3, 1 tr behind the row, 1 dc,  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
\*1 tr behind the row, 1 dc\* 2 times,  
\*1 fp tr around the tr from two rows ago, 1 dc\* 2 times  
1 tr behind the row, 1 dc



Repeat from row 3 until you reach the length you want. Crochet rows 5-10 to get both ends the same.

Finish with crocheting rows 3 and 4 two times more. Either sew or crochet your ends together. Weave in your ends and then you have a brand-new tube scarf.
