



HERE I AM BEANIE



Material

Yarn: Blända from Falkgarn

Yarn usage: 2 skeins

Hook: 8 mm (L)

Förkortningar:

ch – chain stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

blo – crochet in back loop only




Important information

- All rounds starts with ch 2 (if crocheting with hdc) or ch 3 (if crocheting with dc) and counts as the first stitch.
- All rounds ends with 1 slip stitch in the second or third chain (depending on which size).
- Note that you crochet hdc on the smaller sizes and dc on the bigger ones.
- The number in (X) shows how many stitches you should have after every round, including the first stitch made with chains.
- Don't worry if you don't get the same size as the chart, the beanie is stretchable.

1-3 years

Round 1: Start with a magic ring or ch 2 and start in the second ch from the hook. Ch 2 and 7 hdc (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 1 hdc i same stitch, *2 hdc in each stitch* (16)

Round 3: ch 2, 2 hdc i next stitch, *1 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (24)

Round 4: ch 2, 1 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *2 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (32)

Round 5: ch 2, 2 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *3 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (40)

Measure (A)

Round 6-13: ch 2, 1 hdc in each stitch (40)

The ribbing

Don't cut the yarn! You're going to keep crocheting in rows on the edge of the beanie.

Row 1: ch 4, start in the second ch from the hook, 1 sc in each of the remaining stitches, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Row 2: 1 sc in blo on the ribbing part, ch 1

Row 3: 1 sc in blo back to the beanie, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you make around the beanie and either crochet or sew the ribbing together. Fasten your ends and the beanie is done!



4-9 years

Round 1: Start with a magic ring or ch 2 and start in the second ch from the hook. Ch 2 and 7 hdc (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 1 hdc i same stitch, *2 hdc in each stitch* (16)

Round 3: ch 2, 2 hdc i next stitch, *1 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (24)

Round 4: ch 2, 1 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *2 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (32)

Round 5: ch 2, 2 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *3 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (40)

Round 6: ch 2, 8 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *9 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (44)

Measure (A)

Round 7-14: ch 2, 1 hdc in each stitch (44)

The ribbing

Don't cut the yarn! You're going to keep crocheting in rows on the edge of the beanie.

Row 1: ch 4, start in the second ch from the hook, 1 sc in each of the remaining stitches, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Row 2: 1 sc in blo on the ribbing part, ch 1

Row 3: 1 sc in blo back to the beanie, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you make around the beanie and either crochet or sew the ribbing together. Fasten your ends and the beanie is done!

10-14 years

Round 1: Start with a magic ring or ch 2 and start in the second ch from the hook. Ch 2 and 7 hdc (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 1 hdc i same stitch, *2 hdc in each stitch* (16)

Round 3: ch 2, 2 hdc i next stitch, *1 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (24)

Round 4: ch 2, 1 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *2 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (32)

Round 5: ch 2, 2 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *3 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (40)

Varv 6: ch 2, 3 hdc, 2 hdc i next stitch, *4 hdc, 2 hdc in next stitch* (48)

Measure (A)

Round 6-15: ch 2, 1 hdc in each stitch (48)

The ribbing


Don't cut the yarn! You're going to keep crocheting in rows on the edge of the beanie.

Row 1: ch 4, start in the second ch from the hook, 1 sc in each of the remaining stitches, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Row 2: 1 sc in blo on the ribbing part, ch 1

Row 3: 1 sc in blo back to the beanie, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you make around the beanie and either crochet or sew the ribbing together. Fasten your ends and the beanie is done!



Teen/Small

Round 1: Start with a magic ring or ch 3 and start in the second ch from the hook. Ch 2 and 9 dc (10)

Round 2: ch 3, 1 dc i same stitch, *2 hdc in each stitch* (20)

Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc i next stitch, *1 hdc, 2 dc in next stitch* (30)

Round 4: ch 3, 1 dc, 2 dc i next stitch, *2 dc, 2 dc in next stitch* (40)

Round 5: ch 3, 2 dc, 2 dc i next stitch, *3 dc, 2 dc in next stitch* (50)

Measure (A)

Round 6-11: ch 3, 1 dc in each stitch (50)

The ribbing

Don't cut the yarn! You're going to keep crocheting in rows on the edge of the beanie.

Row 1: ch 4, start in the second ch from the hook, 1 sc in each of the remaining stitches, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Row 2: 1 sc in blo on the ribbing part, ch 1

Row 3: 1 sc in blo back to the beanie, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you make around the beanie and either crochet or sew the ribbing together. Fasten your ends and the beanie is done!



Medium

Round 1: Start with a magic ring or ch 3 and start in the second ch from the hook. Ch 2 and 9 dc (10)

Round 2: ch 3, 1 dc i same stitch, *2 hdc in each stitch* (20)

Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc i next stitch, *1 hdc, 2 dc in next stitch* (30)

Round 4: ch 3, 1 dc, 2 dc i next stitch, *2 dc, 2 dc in next stitch* (40)

Round 5: ch 3, 2 dc, 2 dc i next stitch, *3 dc, 2 dc in next stitch* (50)

Measure (A)

Round 6-12: ch 3, 1 dc in each stitch (50)

The ribbing

Don't cut the yarn! You're going to keep crocheting in rows on the edge of the beanie.

Row 1: ch 4, start in the second ch from the hook, 1 sc in each of the remaining stitches, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Row 2: 1 sc in blo on the ribbing part, ch 1

Row 3: 1 sc in blo back to the beanie, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you make around the beanie and either crochet or sew the ribbing together. Fasten your ends and the beanie is done!

Large

Round 1: Start with a magic ring or ch 3 and start in the second ch from the hook. Ch 2 and 9 dc (10)

Round 2: ch 3, 1 dc i same stitch, *2 hdc in each stitch* (20)

Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc i next stitch, *1 hdc, 2 dc in next stitch* (30)

Round 4: ch 3, 1 dc, 2 dc i next stitch, *2 dc, 2 dc in next stitch* (40)

Round 5: ch 3, 2 dc, 2 dc i next stitch, *3 dc, 2 dc in next stitch* (50)

Measure (A)

Round 7-11: ch 3, 1 dc in each stitch (55)

The ribbing

Don't cut the yarn! You're going to keep crocheting in rows on the edge of the beanie.

Row 1: ch 4, start in the second ch from the hook, 1 sc in each of the remaining stitches, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Row 2: 1 sc in blo on the ribbing part, ch 1

Row 3: 1 sc in blo back to the beanie, 2 slip stitches in the next stitches of the beanie.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you make around the beanie and either crochet or sew the ribbing together. Fasten your ends and the beanie is done!
